Sheriff's Report - 911 dispatch response to near drowning, recent homicide, Carlyle Lake

There was discussion regarding how the county 911 dispatcher responded to an emergency 911 call of a near drowning of a toddler. Officer Perez explained the protocol and procedures in place for such instances. Officer Perez reviewed the call extensively and played the entire call for the committee in attendance. All committee members agreed the 911 dispatcher was composed, confident and performed the duties of the position extremely well. We asked officer Perez to share the committee's appreciation and congratulations to the dispatcher.

Officer Perez commented on the recent homicide in Clinton County. The Sheriff's department is to be commended on the quick apprehension of the suspect in this case.

Officer Perez reported Carlyle Lake was in full swing with no issues to date.

The county is currently understaffed by 1 full time officer. The Sheriff's department is actively pursuing a qualified person to fill this position.

Sheriff's Report - 911 dispatch response to near drowning, recent homicide, Carlyle Lake

- CAD Program is moving along with training to begin mid-September
 - Tablets have already been purchased, with a possible go live date of late Sept/early Oct.
- The new hire for the deputy position remains in the works, the sheriff feels they are getting closer to filling the position.
- The process of ordering 16 body cameras has been set into motion. This has been mandated by the state to be in effect by 2025. The current budget allows for this expense, so there will be no extra tax dollars needed to cover the cost. Body cams will be a positive for the county residents and officers.
- Dan signed a contract for a new free Sheriff's Department App available to the public. Dan will explain what this app will do for county residents.

CCEM Director's Report

The committee nominates Tony Petrea to assume the position of CCEM Deputy Director, replacing Tim Schleper.

Tony gave the following report:

- The "big shed" organization is in the works, looks to be completed soon.
- John Skain continues to update all computers

- Generators currently in possession are to be mounted on existing trailers
 - Recent damage due to storms in WA County required the need to activate IRMA (the counties mobile emergency response vehicle. During the activation it was discovered the radio system was not working properly. This too is in the process of addressing.
